

THE NEW RIDING SEASON BEGINS



April is the first full month of Spring and when the weather cooperates, the beginning of our riding season. We will begin our riding season with a big ride right of the gates to Pigeon Forge for the Tennessee Spring Fling. Are you ready? Is your motorcycle ready?

Working on the motorcycle to get it ready is the easy part.

A good clean up, oil change and a thorough TCLOCS check should be enough to get it in condition to do a test ride. We will discuss TCLOCS further during the chapter gathering. In the Navy, we called this ride a shake down cruise. It allows you to get the feel of riding your motorcycle again and discover anything you may have missed doing a TCLOCS. After a little trip down the Interstate, take it to an empty parking lot and practice some emergency stops,

emergency swerves and do some figure 8's to sharpen your turning and riding skills. Recheck the tire pressure to make sure you won't have a problem on the road. Don't forget to a check and shake down of your trailer if you are towing one. Hopefully, no problems will be discovered.

We will be riding as a group so a little reminder about group riding. Try to maintain the correct position in the group while riding staggered or single file. Maintain 2 seconds between the rider in front of you or a safe distance depending on conditions like rain. While the ride leader will comment through the CB on hazards ahead, it is up to you to adjust for your own safety. Speaking of rain, plan on it. Have a good rain suit to put on just in case. Take it out of the bag to check it over prior to starting the trip.

Show up to the start of the ride with a full tank and empty bladder. No one should feel pressure to ride when you are uncomfortable. If you need to stop for whatever the reason, announce on the CB you need to stop soon. Everyone will be glad you made the call and will be happy to do it. Also know the route we will be riding. Every time we have done the ride though Maryville, we get separated, sometimes into 3 groups. So, know the routes we will be traveling. The lead group will probably be waiting for the rest of the group to catch up outside of Maryville. Even when riding in a group, keep using the SEE method to stay aware of conditions around you. In case you have forgotten, SEE stands for Search (look for hazards), Evaluate (spot the hazard and plan an escape maneuver) and Execute (make your planned move if the hazard presents itself).

Let's have a great and safe ride, hopefully we won't get wet.

Morsels of Knowledge

- Today there is 266% more fat (and only two thirds the amount of protein) in a piece of chicken than in 1971.
