



GET READY TO RIDE!

It won't be long until the riding season will be upon us and I, like all of us, am looking forward to hopping onto my wing for a little "handlebar therapy". But, before jumping on your steed, a little preventive maintenance needs to be performed on your bike to get it ready for the riding season. TCLOCS is a good start and a thorough inspection by a good mechanic should be enough to verify that your bike is in safe riding condition. Let him know of any problems you may have experienced last year that may require his special attention.



Also, is your safety gear (helmet, gloves, boots, etc.) in good condition or does any of your gear need to be replaced? All this is a "no brainer" and I am just preaching to the choir because we all know what we need to do for our bikes and riding gear to keep us as safe as possible.

Once verified that your bike and equipment are in a safe riding condition, let's look after ourselves. It has been long winter and let's face it, we are a year older and our riding skills are just little rusty from lack of riding time. So, start slowly and get comfortable with the handling, throttle, brakes and overall feel of the bike.

Once comfortable riding one up, time to work on your safe riding skills. Use the SEE method to stay alert to the environment around you. SEE stands for Scan (scan far ahead and around you for dangerous conditions), Evaluate (if a dangerous condition is spotted, plan a tactic to safely avoid the condition), Execute (if the dangerous conditions happens, immediately execute the avoidance plan). When scanning the environment ahead, also develop the technique to scan the mirrors, gages and to each side. To remain constantly aware of the riding environment around us, physical conditioning, mental awareness and practice will also help to make us safer. We also need to develop our riding skills such as cornering, swerving, emergency braking, slow riding, night riding, etc. which we can address with the Shiny Side Up program, which is still in development, this year.

Finally, let us keep this year as safe as last year and enjoy our rides with our friends even more.



Wendy's-Style Chili

Prep Time: 20 min

Cook Time: 2 to 3 hours

Ready In: Around 3 hours

Ingredients:

- 2 lbs. ground beef
- 29 ounces pinto beans
- 1 medium onion, diced
- 1 stalk of celery, diced
- 2 teaspoons cumin
- 2 teaspoons salt
- 2 cups water

- 29 ounces tomato sauce
- 29 ounces of kidney beans
- 2 green chilies, diced
- 3 medium tomatoes, chopped
- 3 tablespoons chili powder
- 2 teaspoons ground black pepper



Step 1: Brown the ground beef into a skillet and use a fork to crumble it into small, pea-sized pieces.

Step 2: Combine the ground beef and all of the remaining ingredients into a large pot and simmer on low heat for 2 to 3 hours, stirring occasionally.
