

# We've Got You Covered

Riding season will be here soon and now is the perfect time to make sure you're covered from head to toe!

1. **Helmet**

Do you have a DOT approved helmet to protect your head? When I first started riding my dad asked the salesman what type of helmet I needed. Steve Fisher said, "If you have a ten dollar head you buy a ten dollar helmet". My dad said "Give him the best you have".

2. **Eye Protection**

Always protect your eyes. If you have a flip faced helmet make sure the shield is always down or wear safety goggles.

3. **Gloves**

Make sure your gloves fit well, are comfortable and constructed for the type of riding you are doing. Your gloves should feel like a second skin.

4. **Jacket and Jeans**

A jacket with skid pads will protect you in case of an accident but will also protect you in other ways. It will protect you from the sun, wind, bugs, and keep you warm. It's better to pull rocks from your jacket than your skin. Long jeans are a must and will protect you in case of an accident from road rash.

5. **Boots**

A good pair of riding boots are necessary to protect your ankles and toes in case of an accident. Be sure your boots are comfortable.

## Fresh Corn Pudding

6 tablespoons of butter  
 6 ears of white or yellow corn, or a mix of the two, shucked  
 3 tablespoons all-purpose flour  
 1 teaspoon salt  
 1 teaspoon cayenne pepper

4 large eggs  
 2 cups whole milk  
 2 tablespoons sugar  
 1 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper



1. Place a rack in the center of the oven and preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Place 2 tablespoons of butter in a 13 x 9-inch glass or ceramic baking dish and place it in the oven while it preheats until the butter melts, then set the baking dish aside.
2. Hold an ear of corn upright on a rimmed baking sheet and, using a sharp knife, cut down close to the cob to slice off the kernels. Then, run the knife down the cob again to extract the milk and any remaining bits of corn kernels. Repeat with the remaining ears of corn. When done, you will have about 3 cups of corn kernels. Set them aside.
3. Warm the milk in a small saucepan over low heat.
4. Meanwhile, separate the eggs, placing the whites in a large mixing bowl and the yolks in another large mixing bowl. Beat the egg whites at high speed with an electric mixer until stiff peaks form, 2 to 3 minutes. Set the egg whites aside.
5. Place the remaining 4 tablespoons of butter in a glass measuring cup and microwave on high power until melted, about 1 minute. Beat the egg yolks with a fork until lemon colored. Whisk in the flour and sugar until well combined. Whisk in the warm milk and the 4 tablespoons of melted butter and season with salt, black pepper, and cayenne pepper.
6. Fold in the corn kernels, then fold in the egg whites until just combined. Spoon the corn mixture into the prepared baking dish and bake until the top is golden and the pudding is just set, 50 to 55 minutes. Serves 8 to 10 people.
